

## IEEE CITATION GUIDE

The IEEE Style Manual **does not** provide guidelines for citing blogs, general websites, or audiovisuals. It may be helpful to ask your professor for more guidance and/or refer to the style guidelines for specific scholarly journals.

Important things to remember when citing in IEEE:

- References are listed by number in the order in which they appear in your document, not in alphabetical order.
- The author's last name is given as part of the sentence and the numerical reference appears in square brackets immediately after the name.
- Only the number inside square brackets is given.
