A woman whose efforts have resulted in a legacy for our community. Called the Legacy, this Dream Award recognizes the person who made significant contributions to the UW Tacoma community in the areas of diversity, social justice or civil rights.

### **Community Organization Dream Award**

#### **Tacoma Black Collective**

A community organization that has demonstrated consistent commitment to diversity and equality through innovative programming, campus and community involvement, activism and leadership development.
