### **Unfinished Business:**

Advisor Conor talked about the elections calendar. Some of the dates and times have stayed the same and some have changed. On Monday March 4th at 8:00am candidate election & ballot measure packets available on ASUWT Website. ASUWT Candidate Filing Form available on ASUWT Website. On Thursday, April 18 and Friday, April 19 from 12:30PM-1:30PM there will be a mandatory candidate meetings and you must attend one. On the 18th it will be at UWY103 and the 19th will be at UWY 307. There will also be individual meetings in case academics do not allow for that timeslot. On Monday, April 22, 2024 at 8:00AM open campaigning begins and you cannot have promote yourself before that day and possibly a fine. On Tuesday, April 23, 2024 from 12:30PM-1:30PM there will be a candidate tabling event at William Philip Hall this will allow students to meet the candidates.

From monday April 29-May 3, candidate forum week will start, although dates, times, modalities, and locations may shift based on participation. Senator Candidates will be on Monday April 29, from 12:30pm-1:30pm at multiple locations throughout campus, in each school's area. On Tuesday April 30, from 12:30PM-1:30PM and 1:30PM – 2:00PM (After time to talk w/ Candidates) the Directors of University Affairs, Directors of Outreach, and the Directors of Finance will be the focus on that day. On Wednesday May 1, from 12:30PM-2:00PM focus will be on the Directors of Student Technology, Directors of Internal Communications & Affairs, and the Directors of Legislative Affairs. On Thursday May 2, from 12:30PM-2:00PM there will be the Presidential Debate. On Friday May 3 it will be a potential overflow day in the event of influx of candidates.

On Friday, May 10, 2024 at 5:00pm there will be a deadline to withdraw from Elections and the endorsement deadline. On Monday, May 13, at 8:00am voting opens. During the week of May 13, from 11am-3pm the Rock the Vote Event will occur, although location subjected to change due to space availability. On Friday, May 17, 2024 at 11:59pm voting closes and voting will be on dubnet. On Monday, May 20, at 5:00pm all campaign materials must be removed, the expense declaration forms are due, all election code complaint determinations are due, voter verification and election results announced. On Wednesday, May 29, 2024 at 5:00pm all appeals to election code complaint submissions are due and the write-in candidate filing deadline.

### **New Business:**

Senator Angell talks about the NSUF Committee. It is a committee that goes over the first time fee for freshman and transfer students during the first year and the fee has to be paid. Looking to increase budget again and they wanted to start in January. It will be 1 hour a month and discuss what was presented and its a good way to see how budgets are being run. Committee is looking for student government to participate. No limit of who can join the committee and meetings will be on zoom from 5pm-6pm once a month. You give your opinions and ask questions about why increase and decrease budgets for specific topics. Presenting to the board of regions and giving your opinion and advocate what is best for students.

**Senate Updates:**

Senator Angell spoke for Outreach. He is working with Senator Wicklund to copartner an event with SAB and it will be a Bob Ross event.

Director Song asked the senators if they have met with their dean yet. So far senator Duncan, Amaya, Campbell and Wicklund have met with their dean so far.

**Advisor Updates:**
